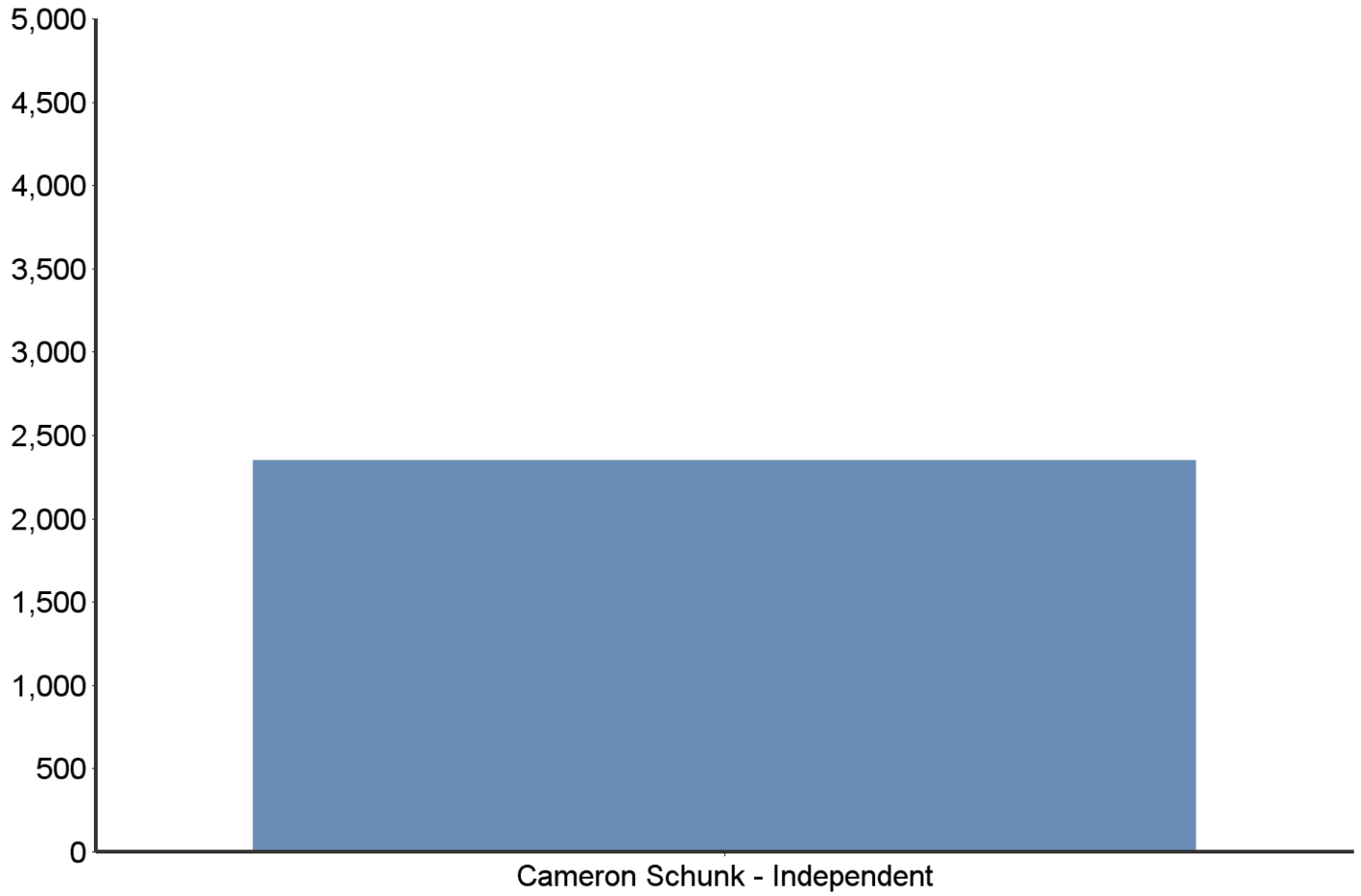
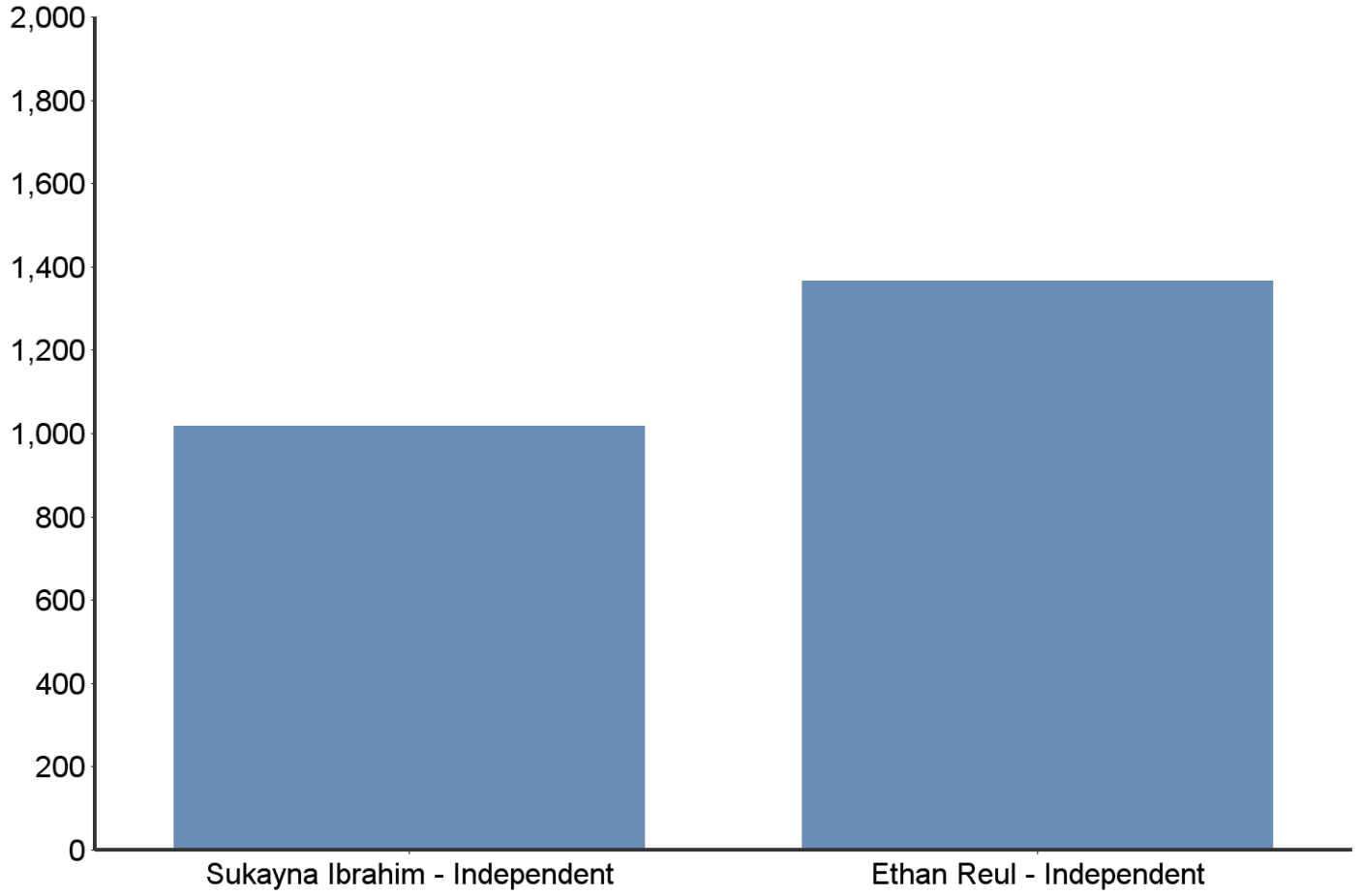

Legal Resource Center Fee Increase:

Legal Resource Center- Putting Students First

The Associated Students Legal Resource Center (LRC) provides legal education, advice and consultation to UCSB students on topics such as criminal citations or arrests, landlord-tenant disputes, marriage or divorce, consumer complaints, traffic tickets, personal injury, harassment, and debtor – creditor issues, among others.

The funding will go towards the LRC’s goals of operating a Self-Help Legal Center in Isla Vista, implementing a Sobering Center Program, and will contribute to daily office operations, facility rent, and staffing.

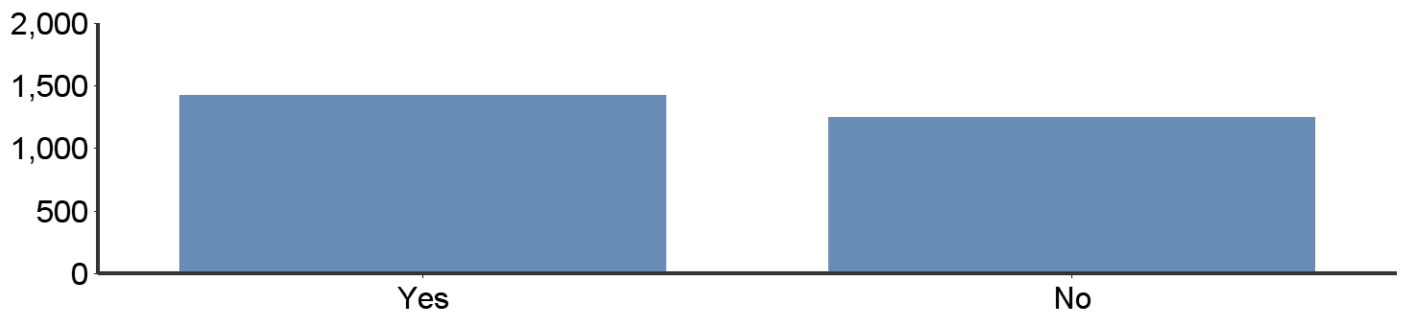

The fee will be assessed beginning fall of 2015. The fee will decrease over the next four (4) years due to Legal Resource Center programs that will become self-sustaining, after which the per student/per quarter fee will be \$4.75. Of the \$6.50 collected for the LRC, \$3.00 will be applied to the operation and maintenance costs of the LRC service; \$0.50 will be applied to the operation and maintenance of the Self Help Legal Center; and \$3.00 will be applied to the implementation, operation and maintenance of the Sobering Center Program.
