56. AS Bike Committee Fee Increase to Further Improve Bike Infrastructure: The current UCSB AS Bike Committee and its associated fee were established in 1998. Since the creation of this fee will be in addition to the existing fees of \$1.57 for Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters and \$1.32 for Summer quarter, and a capital improvement lock in for the construction of the new bike racks. The current base fee is up for reaffirmation \$ 1.57 Fall, Winter and Spring and \$1.32 for Summer this election.
